This is a wonderful two-story folk Victorian with German siding in the Five Forks neighborhood of the Old West End Historic District. The exterior is totally restored and structurally reconditioned top to bottom. A new main electrical panel and some wiring is complete. This is an ideal starter home for the handy history buff. Select your own interior fittings to make it your own (to be sold incomplete).

Adjacent to the now-burgeoning River District, the Five Forks neighborhood is targeted for revitalization by the city. Across from an attractive courtyard-style development with convenient local shops planned by the city that promises to add value to this property.

In addition to a sunny sitting area on the landing, this home's second floor has two large (14 x 14) bedrooms, both with fireplaces, and a full bath. For extra storage, a folding stairway to the stand-up attic could easily be added.

The main floor includes a spacious foyer, half bath, and three large rooms that can be configured as living room /dining room / kitchen or as third bedroom / family room /eat-in kitchen. The living room (14 x 14) has a fireplace with beautiful original tiles and overmantel and original chandelier. Pine Street was laid out in the 1850s or before, and was the route trod by Jefferson Davis during Danville's time as the last capitol of the Confederate States of America. This dwelling began life about 1900, sheltering its first occupants not on Pine Street, but nearby on Loyal Street near Wilson. Twenty years on, it proved the sole survivor of four houses removed in 1923 for a new filling station built at that corner when it was relocated to 815 Pine Street on a then-vacant lot.

The house was saved a second time by OWE Restorations during 2015 when it was slated for demolition due to structural deficiencies. Now sturdy and stable, this historic home awaits its next owner-occupant.

This two-story frame dwelling, which originally included only five rooms, was conveyed in trust for Sallie E., also known as Sarah E., Clark, and her children on February 15, 1890, from the Estate of William S. Patton. Mr. Patton was a principal in the respected banking firm of Win S. Patton, Sons & Co., established in 1865.

In 1915, the home was sold to two sisters, Mrs. Posey W. Ashworth and Florence M. Ramey, for \$2,800. Mrs. Ramey was a grocer at the corner of Dame and Green streets. The 1925 City Directory lists the family business, Ramey & Ashworth, Inc., as dealing in real estate, rentals, loans, and general insurance at its office in the Dudley Building.

In 1928, the home was sold for \$5500 to Elsie G. Anglin, who resided there with her husband, William B. Anglin. Mr. Anglin was employed as a mechanic at the city's Light & Power Station, and later in 1930, became the Chief Engineer of the City Electric Plant. Mrs. Anglin, who was widowed in 1943, lived in the Pine Street home until 1949 when she moved to 133 Holbrook Avenue. Purchased by E.C. Gerringer in 1972, the first tenants were Robert Conington and Alex Crawley. The home was used as a rental, including a period in 1986 when it was an Averett College fraternity house, until it was purchased by the current owners at an auction in 1988. Determined to purchase and restore, Mr. Wellbank and Mr. Maddox finalized the transaction with a bank credit card because no lender would assume the risk of financing even at the sales price of \$2,700.

When the owners started to stabilize the structure, the right back corner of the stairwell had to be raised eighteen inches from settling due to a leaking roof. The kitchen was originally a wraparound porch, part of which served as a pantry before becoming the first full bath. The first kitchen was across the hall in a totally separate building connected by a breezeway to the home.

The furniture in the dining room, which was an addition, is older than the home. The Empire table and chairs date from the 1870's. The china cabinet was brought to Charlottesville from Pennsylvania in 1913 by Mr. Maddox's grandfather. In the formal parlor, the rug in front of the fireplace is a Tabriz, and the Queen Anne furniture is cherry. His restoration in progress provides a glimmer of hope for other property owners on the street.

Tour Book 1997:

Unique in Danville, and a rarity in much of the state, the picturesque house at 879 Pine Street survives from the days of antebellum Danville when Pine and Chestnut were new streets and the trees for which they were named, the scrub and loblolly pines and the now-nearly-extinct American chestnut dominated the Eastern forests. Referred to as the "House in the Pines" in Farrar and Hines's book *Old Virginia Houses: The Heart of Virginia*, the house certainly conjures up the quaint forest images reminiscent of the Gingerbread House in Hansel and Gretel.

Evidence from local deed and land books suggests the structure was built sometime between 1853, when Dr. Nathaniel T. Green first sold this parcel unimproved, and 1857, when the records suggest there was already a dwelling on the lot. By 1857, another esteemed local physician, Dr. Thomas D. Stokes, had acquired part interest in the property. Local tradition holds it was Dr. Stokes who built this Gothic- Revival-style cottage. It would appear that Dr. Stokes, a native of Caswell County and graduate of the "Medical College in Philadelphia," had an affinity

for the Gothic Revival style. Shortly after he returned to Danville and began his practice about 1843, he is known to have constructed a board-and-batten Gothic-style house, on the corner of Green at Chestnut Street, before the house at 879 Pine Street he is presumed to have built.

Dr. Stokes is reported to have “amassed considerable wealth,” and property, including the area still called Stokesland, at the south end of Danville. A lifelong bachelor, Dr. Stokes left no direct heirs. In 1894, several years after his death, his house passed to a niece Lemma P. Withers, the wife of one of Dr. Stokes’ executors, Col. Elijah B. Withers, a prominent local attorney. After Mrs. Withers’ death in 1907, the estate was settled the following year through a sale to an adjacent neighbor, the florist Mr. H.W. Brown. For many years thereafter the Brown’s son Dudley lived in the house. After his death in 1966 it was purchased for use as rental property by Mitchell R. Cope, who lived next door at 871 Pine Street. After his death in 1986, Mrs. Cope continued for several years to live on Pine Street and lease the Gothic Revival cottage as apartments. She died in 1994, the same year her administrators sold the 879 Pine Street property to Anne Carter Lee Gravely.

No stranger to historic preservation, Anne Carter Lee Gravely lives in her family’s old home, Mount Pleasant, a handsome Greek Revival brick dwelling she maintains in Rocky Mount, Virginia. Highly regarded as an architectural historian, she is also a trustee of the Preservation Alliance of Virginia and sits on the Advisory Board of the Roanoke Regional Preservation Office. She is lead author of a forthcoming volume *Virginia: Valley, South and West*, part of the series *Buildings of the United States*, published by the Society of Architectural Historians and Oxford Press.

Attracted by Danville’s wealth of Victorian architecture, Ms. Gravely recognized the potential of this outstanding Gothic Revival Cottage of stucco over brick. Her careful rehabilitation which, as she describes it, remains a “work in progress,” has ensured the preservation of a singular structure. Its small scale, use of steep gable ends, sawn barge-boarding and lancet arched windows ally it with the designs of the landscape architect Andrew Jackson Downing who popularized such cottages in the mid-nineteenth century. One can imagine that this house may have been lifted from an architectural pattern book of the type published by Downing and his contemporaries. For the exterior of the structure, Ms. Gravely has employed a palette of earth tones that were favored by the pre-Civil War architects and designers who promoted these “organic” structures in natural settings over the “garish” white-washed Greek- and Classical-Revival “temples”, nowhere more popular than in the South. To the right of the house there is a complementary nineteenth century-style “living” gazebo of gnarled grapevines that makes a picturesque sight in the full leaf of summer, or even bare.

Interior features retain the Gothic flavor as well. The lancet design is apparent especially in the staircase with pointed arches which grace the paneling beneath the stairs and the balusters just under the handrail.

Tour Book 2001:

Conjuring up images of the gingerbread house in Hansel and Gretel, this Gothic Revival cottage is unique in Danville and a rarity in much of the state. It was built in the mid-1850s, presumably by its first known resident—one of the town’s early and esteemed physicians—Dr. Thomas D.

Stokes. Lancet-arched windows and teardrop bargeboard decoration ally it with the patternbook designs of such advocates of the Gothic style as Andrew Jackson Downing, the landscape architect, and his contemporaries.

Interior features evidence the Gothic flavor as well. The lancet design is apparent especially in the staircase with pointed arches which grace the paneling beneath the stairs and the balusters just under the handrail.

Seven years ago, Anne Carter Lee Gravely, a resident of Rocky Mount, Virginia, purchased the house to preserve and restore its singular architectural character, inside and out. For the past year this dwelling has been home to Ms. Dorothy Nesbitt, whose interest in preservation is more than avocational; she directs the City's Downtown renaissance as Danville participates in the National Main Street Program.
